

**MINUTES**


The meeting was called to order by Dr. Ranck. The first order of business was to ratify the minutes of the May 11, 1993 meeting. On motion by Mr. Stebbins, seconded by Dr. Ranck, the minutes were approved as previously distributed.

The Committee then entertained a request from Pearl River Basin Development District for an exemption from participation in MMRS. The Committee, not wishing to establish a precedent of granting exemptions, declined to consider the request and instructed Mr. Winegarden to draft a letter to the District acknowledging that, while the District will not be directly involved in the state accounting, payroll or human resource systems, they may be asked to provide data for the Executive Information System, and therefore will remain a part of the System.


Mr. Winegarden then gave the Committee an update on the MMRS organization, budget, and various projects. The Committee considered a change to the previously-approved basic organizational structure but deferred formal action until Mr. Stringer, the newly-appointed State Personnel Director, could review the structure. Mr. Winegarden was authorized to proceed with implementation of the structure pending formal approval.

The Committee then set the date of the next meeting for July 7, 1993, at 2:00 p.m., in the conference room of the Department of Finance and Administration, 550 High Street, 901 Walter Sillers Building, Jackson, Mississippi.

There being no further business to come before the Committee, Mr. Stebbins moved for the Committee to adjourn. Mr. Gregory seconded the motion. The motion being made and properly carried, the Committee adjourned.
