

Transparency Mississippi – Lease Data

The Mississippi Accountability and Transparency Act of 2008 (MATA) mandates specific reporting pertaining to contracts and leases. All leases, including the leasing Agency, City, and Purpose can be found at: www.transparency.mississippi.gov. In order to help facilitate the public's inquiries pertaining to current lease agreements between the State of Mississippi and the private sector, users can go to the web address above and use the guidelines below as a helpful guide to find information pertaining to current leases:

1. Go to www.transparency.mississippi.gov
2. Select the box in the center of the page entitled "Leases."
3. Next to the "Select Query Option," pull down and select "Search by Agency Name."
4. Here, each State Agency and Institution is linked, where users can select any particular agency they wish to see.
5. Once you select a State Agency or Institution, it will show all leases for that particular Agency or Institution.
6. You can select any Contract Number that will provide you with the details of that specific lease.
