Wouldn't a per hour rate for each unit be a better platform and standard to go by than the example given in that page. I would prefer a per unit price as each location has different needs and demands. | Sections 5.4 – Scope of Services, Page 3 and Estimated # of Workers, Attachment B, Page 19 | <p>Based on the needs of each individual agency, this IFB requests each vender to identify not only its per-hour rate, but also the number of workers that add up to the hourly rate. This column should be used by vendors to estimate how many workers will be included in the hourly price they have listed.</p> <p>Using the example - Attachment B - in the IFB, a vender has a mowing hourly rate of \$63.00 per hour for an estimated 2 workers. The price used to determine placement on the Preapproved Vendor List would be \$31.50 per person, per hour.</p> <p>If the specific work-site requires the vendor to use 4 workers, then the vendor's hourly rate for 4 workers will be \$126.00 (\$31.50 per person, per hour).</p> <p>Detailed scope and specific requirements of the work required will be provided by the Contracting Agency when a Vendor on the PVL is selected for consideration with respect to a specific project or need.</p> |
