Per Mississippi Code Section 31-11-27, it is time to prepare the Study of Capital Needs of immediate and future Repair and Renovation, Capital Improvement, and Preplanning needs for fiscal years 2022-2026. The deadline for submission is **Friday, May 15, 2020, though agencies or institutions with Tour Dates in May are requested to submit sooner.**

Attached is a copy of the **Project Request Database Spreadsheet** which will be used as the source of information for R&R tours and as the basis for the **Study of Capital Needs** that our Office submits to the Legislative Budget Office, per law, later in the year documenting and recommending Preplanning, Repair and Renovation, and Capital Improvement requests to the State Legislature.

Instructions for completing the spreadsheet are attached and can also be found on the Bureau of Building's web site. The **Project Data Summary Form** will be generated automatically from the database within our Office.
