Call to Order

The meeting was chaired and called to order by Ms. Liz Welch, Chairman of the Board.

Agenda Item 1: Third Party Administration Services Request for Proposals

Chairman Welch recognized Ms. Cindy Bradshaw, Deputy Director with the Office of Insurance, who reminded Board members that the current contract with Blue Cross & Blue Shield of Mississippi is scheduled to expire on December 31, 2021. The Board previously authorized staff to prepare a request for proposals and initiate the procurement process for the Third Party Administration Services contract. Due to various unforeseen incidents, the release of the Request for Proposal has been delayed. As a result, completion of the procurement and contracting process cannot be accomplished as previously scheduled in a manner that will allow sufficient time for potential implementation and transition to a new vendor by the January 1, 2022 effective date. Staff recommended to the subcommittee that the Board consider executing a one year emergency contract with Blue Cross & Blue Shield of Mississippi; thus, allowing the effective date of the new contract to be procured by the RFP to be moved to January 1, 2023. A motion was made by Mr. Mike Chaney to approve negotiating a one year emergency contract with Blue Cross & Blue Shield of Mississippi to run from January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022. Mr. Larry Fortenberry seconded the motion. The motion passed by a 7 - 0 vote, with members Chaney, Formby, Fortenberry, Gavin (designee for Member Wright), Hardwick, Higgins, and Mayfield voting affirmatively.

Adjournment

Chairman Welch announced that the next regular meeting of the State and School Employees Health Insurance Management Board is scheduled for 9:00 a.m., on Wednesday, February 24, 2021.
