About the Position

This position will be responsible for the administration of VMware, Microsoft 365, Microsoft Endpoint Manager (Intune), Active Directory, Azure Active Directory, Azure public cloud services, Windows Server, and Network (switch, Wi-Fi, firewall, etc.). Fourth-level professional position accountable for the development of network architecture and design. Establishes network standards, platforms, protocols, and devices within the approved architecture. Designs complex networks and communications systems. Coordinates and oversees the planning, and installation of complex networks and communication systems. Conducts high level network performance tuning. Establishes statewide integration and continuity of connectivity. Coordinates the integration with external service providers. Research developments in network and communication technology, proposes business changes and develops migration and implementation plans. Provides complex technical support in relevant field of discipline. May serve as project lead or provide supervision and technical direction to lower-level team members. Mentors less experienced staff.

What you'll need to be Successful

This position requires the ability to work and learn independently as well as collaborate with other members of the team, initiative, and vision to find weaknesses in existing processes and infrastructure and produce and implement solutions, ability to automate day to day tasks and willingness to continue to learn and grow with new technologies in a rapidly changing landscape.
