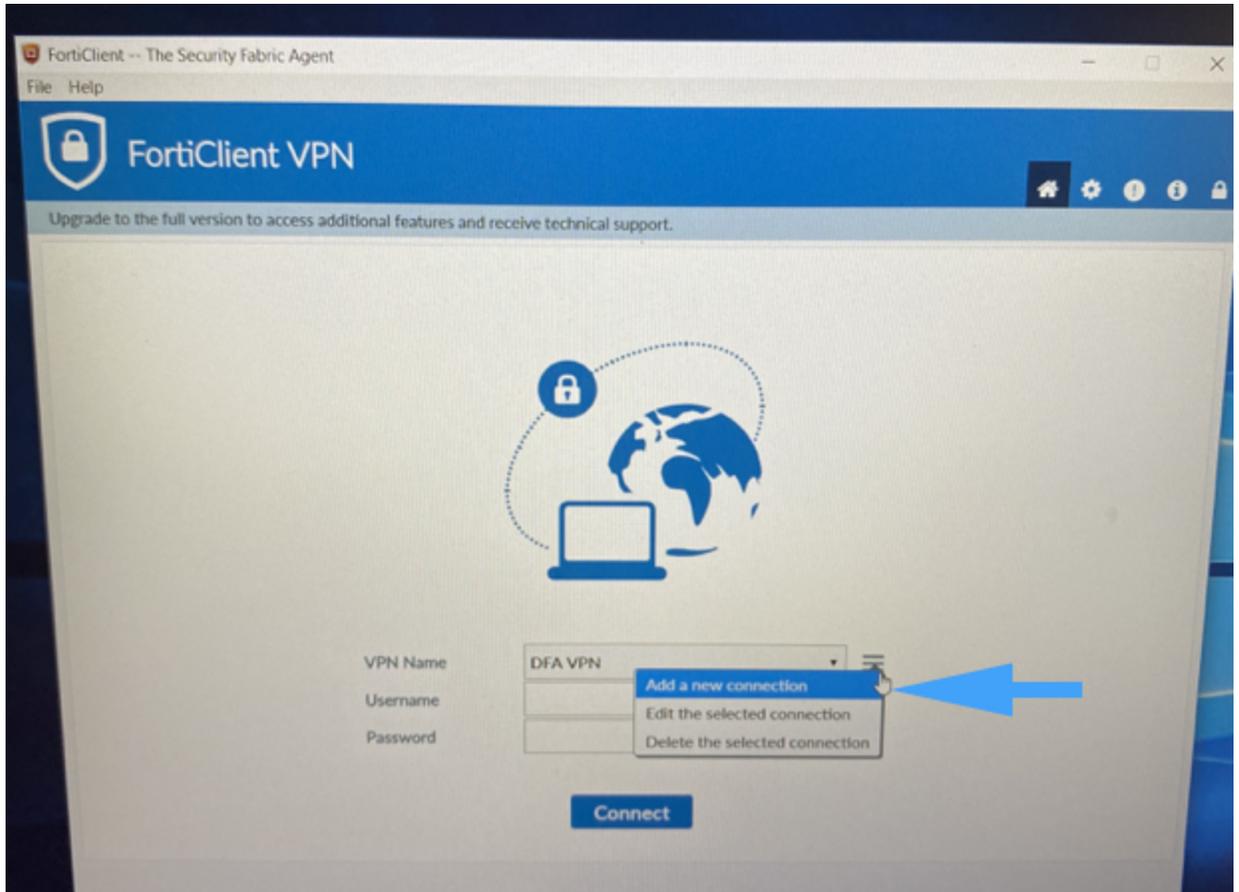
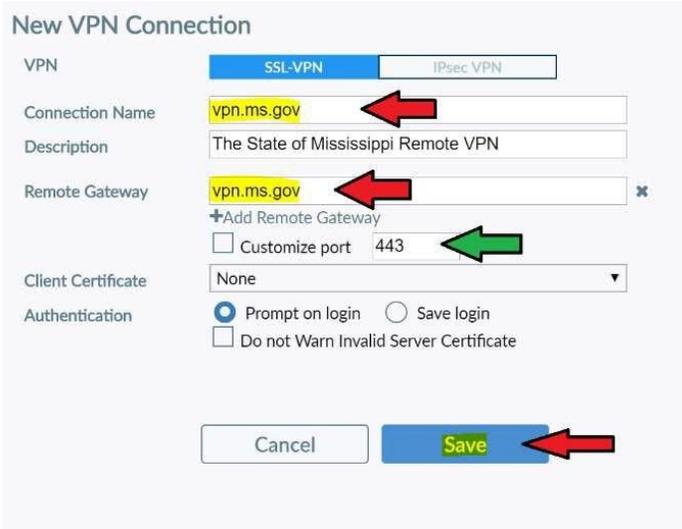


1. Open up the VPN Client on your computer.

3. Select Add a new connection from the drop down.



4. Enter “vpn.ms.gov” for the Connection name and remote gateway of the new connection, verify the default port is “443” and click save.

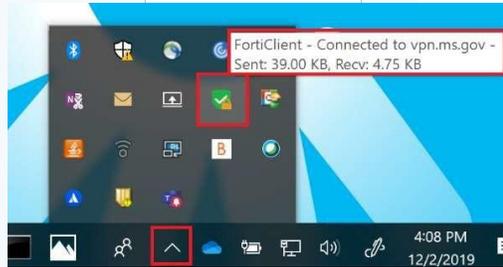
