The warranty period has been extended from 3 years or 36,000 to 10 years/ 100,000 miles for the Driver and Passenger Sliding Door Power Lock Actuators. Some of the vehicles within the above referenced population may experience a clicking/buzzing sound when cycling the sliding door power locks, inoperable power locks on the sliding doors, or sliding doors stuck closed due to a failed lock actuator. If you are experiencing one of these conditions now, or in the future, simply contact your dealer to have the appropriate repairs performed.

The vehicles may have a condition that could cause the evaporative emissions purge pump to fail. If this condition occurs, the Malfunction Indicator Lamp (Check Engine Light) will illuminate, and a diagnostic trouble code will set.

General Motors provides owners with additional protection for the conditions described above. If you believe that your vehicle has the condition described above, repairs and adjustments qualifying under the special coverage must be performed by a General Motors dealer.

Fiscal Year End Vehicle Purchases

Fiscal Year End Preparations for Vehicle Purchases

As the end of the fiscal year quickly approaches, BFM recommends that agencies initiate communication with their fleet vendors to ensure timely delivery of vehicles that have been ordered but not yet received. Taking these steps now will help avoid delays and ensure compliance with fiscal year-end purchasing requirements.

Suggested Actions:

- Request estimated delivery dates for all pending vehicle orders
- Confirm vendors have all required documents and no action is pending from your agency
- Monitor order bank closures and purchasing notes posted on the BFM website, as these may impact availability and ordering timelines
- Document any confirmed purchases potentially needing a waiver request through Office of Fiscal Management (OFM)
