DISENFECT YOUR PLANE/TRAIN/BUS SEAT Wipe down armrest, seat belts, buckles, tray tables and seat pockets to get rid of the previous travelers' germs.

EXERCISE DAILY Try to squeeze in some exercise each day. Walking the airport during a layover. Take advantage of hotel gym. Walking to sight vs. taking a car/bus / train.

EATING HEALTHY Avoid too much junk food and alcohol and commit to eating fruits and vegetables with every meal. Pack healthy snacks like nuts, fruit or protein bars. Keep energy up and avoid temptation.

<u>Fiscal Year End Preparations for Vehicle Purchases</u>

As the end of the fiscal year quickly approaches, BFM recommends that agencies initiate communication with their fleet vendors to ensure timely delivery of vehicles that have been ordered but not yet received. Taking these steps now will help avoid delays and ensure compliance with fiscal year-end purchasing requirements.

Suggested Actions:

- Request estimated delivery dates for all pending vehicle orders.
- Confirm vendors have all required documents and no action is pending from your agency
- Monitor order bank closures and purchasing notes posted on the BFM website, as these may impact availability and ordering timelines Document any confirmed purchases potentially needing a waiver request through Office of Fiscal Management (OFM).

Continental Battery Contract - 8200061146

Effective immediately, the current statewide battery contract,

Continental Battery Co – Contract No. 8200061146, has been temporarily locked due to vendor-proposed price increases related to newly imposed tariffs.

Agencies should **utilize normal purchasing procedures** for all battery acquisitions until further notice. This includes obtaining competitive quotes and following all applicable procurement guidelines for noncontract purchases.

We will provide updates as they become available.

If your agency needs to **process an invoice** related to this contract, please contact Arnitra Douglas to have the contract temporarily unlocked for payment.
