The University of Southern Mississippi requested approval of a sole source research purchase agreement for Bellamare In Situ Ichthyoplanton Imaging System (ISIIS) designed to image sufficient volumes of water to accurately quantify rare meso and macro plankton such as larval fishes and associated planters in situ. It is the only system that integrates very high resolution imagery on an undulating vehicle fitted with a suite of oceanographic sensors. The system design is also unique in the volume of water that is imaged. The purchase of this equipment is an integral component of the research to be completed in the GoMRI funded Consortium for oil spill exposure pathways in Coastal River-Dominated Ecosystems (CONCORDE). Bellamare remains the only qualified ocean engineering company to build specialized scientific equipment of this specific nature. The University of Southern Mississippi requested approval of a sole source contract with Bellamare, in the amount of \$557,845.00, from March 4, 2015 through August 17, 2015 for underwater imaging system research. Mr. Phillips made a motion to approve. Mr. Snowden seconded and the motion carried.






Mr. Kornbrek presented the following:
