LEASE DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

I, Melinda L. McGrath, as Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of Transportation, duly authorized by the Mississippi Transportation Commission, executed the attached lease for space at the "Ford Pit" located at the North end of the Woods Road on property owned by Danny Ford, which is 1.7 miles south of Byram, Mississippi, along the West I-55 frontage road, effective <u>March 25, 2015</u> through October 31, 2015.

The purpose for issuing this Emergency Lease is as follows: a construction project for Interstate 55 from Byram to McDowell Road in Hinds County, Mississippi, was terminated by the Mississippi Transportation Commission January 5, 2015. At that time, the Commission also authorized an emergency contract for the temporary maintenance of the construction site to ensure the safety of the public. The Mississippi Department of Transportation immediately began to inventory materials purchased by the State for the terminated project which had not yet been installed or incorporated in the project. It was determined that over Four Million Dollars in stockpiled construction materials (primarily made of concrete and steel) were located at the above location. In order to secure those State-purchased materials until such time as a new Contractor can be procured through the appropriate processes, the attached lease was executed. There was not sufficient time to advertise for such a lease, and any lease with another party would necessarily have involved the added expense of moving the construction materials from the above location. Given the emergency situation, and, given that the construction materials were already at the location, it was determined that a lease was necessary to secure these State-owned items where they were.

I understand that any Lease executed under this Declaration of Emergency cannot exceed twelve (12) months. This Lease must be presented to Real Property Management and taken before the Public Procurement Review Board for ratification and concurrence.
