This request from the Mississippi Department of Banking and Consumer Finance is for an increase in the annual rental amount in the amount of \$17,030.40 for HVAC usage outside or normal business hours and weekends. The original RFP did not specify any HVAC usage outside of normal business hours. Because Banking has many staff working after hours and on weekends, they have requested the landlord provide heating and cooling after normal business hours, as well as weekends. Based on utilities for the last twelve (12) months at this location, prorated for the amount of space leased in the building, the increase for the HVAC to run for eighteen (18) hours per day, including weekends, is \$17,030.40 per year, or \$1.48 per square foot. All other terms and conditions of the original Lease Agreement remain the same. This Lease originally began on September 1, 2014.
