<u>Dist 3 Substation Sewer (EMER)</u>

<u>Mississippi Department of Public Safety</u>

The Department of Public Safety is requesting assistance from the Department of Finance and Administration / Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property Management, regarding sewer main under the District 3, Troop E Substation in Batesville, Mississippi that continues to clog up creating sewage backup into the building – which is now creating a health risk to the public and the employees.

The Bureau of Building, et al, is requesting approval for expenditure from the Capital Expense Fund for FY16; and, proceeding with project for said emergency, with the Professional obtaining bids in the above mentioned project.

NOTE: Code 27-103-303 allows up to \$500,000.00 for any single emergency with a cap of \$2,000,000.00 per fiscal year. This request is for \$500,000.00 of the FY16 Capital Expense Funds. The Department of Public Safety's Declaration is attached. With PPRB approval herein, the Department of Finance and Administration Emergency Certificate will be drafted, along with the letters for distribution to the seven entities named in the statute for notification of expenditure from the Capital Expense Fund.

Dear Mr. Kornbrek:

- I, Albert Santa-Cruz, Commissioner of the Mississippi Department of Public Safety, do hereby make the following findings and determinations pursuant to authority provided in Section 31-7-13(j), **Mississippi Code** 1972, Annotated:
 - (a) That, there is an emergency at the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol District 3, Troop E Substation, 22000 Highway 35 N, Batesville, Mississippi, which involves the sewer main underneath the aforementioned building that continues to clog up creating sewage backup into the building. This issue creates a health risk to the public and the employees of The Mississippi Department of Public Safety (MDPS) who visit and work at the subject facility.
 - (b) That MDPS in conjunction with Upchurch Plumbing Services has investigated the cause of this issue by way of running a camera through the sewer main, which identified two issues. The first issue discovered during this investigation was a sag in the middle of the sewer line which was holding waste solids and waste water. The second issue that was discovered, was the 90 degree flow sleeve that connects the sewer main to the building discharge sewer line was installed backwards causing the majority of the waste to continue down the sewer main, past the mentioned flow sleeve and down to a dead end in the pipe in lieu of the waste moving down the sewer main, through the flow sleeve, and out the discharge line. Once the waste builds up past the flow sleeve it clogs the outlet to the sewer discharge line which blocks all sewage from flowing out of the building.
 - (c) That, delaying repairs to give opportunity for competitive bidding would be detrimental to the best interest of the MDPS employees and public citizens being served at MDPS because of the health risks this presents.

By means of this Emergency Certificate, we request the Bureau of Buildings, Grounds and Real Property Management to take the necessary steps for immediate repairs to the sewer main serving the Mississippi Highway Patrol, District 3, Troop E Substation.
