The Division of Real Property Management requests concurrence and approval of the following:

(a) PARCHMAN FARMLAND

1. Consider a request from Mississippi Department of Corrections to assign/sub-lease approximately 730.79 acres of tracts 31 & 32 located in the Mississippi State Penitentiary Farmland in Sunflower County, Mississippi from Wayne Carlisle of Carlisle Farms to Thomas Burrell for the 2017 crop year per paragraph 18 of the original Lease regarding assignments. All terms and conditions, including the yearly rental amounts per acre will remain the same as in the original Lease between the Lessee and the State of Mississippi. The Lessee and sub-lessee will both be responsible for the tract(s) until expiration of the lease term which is January 14th, 2018. Should the PPRB decide not to approve the Assignment/Sub-Lease, the Lessee will retain the tract(s) completely. The original lease was approved by PPRB on February 3rd, 2017. The yearly amount of 53,630.53 will be paid to the State for the 2017 growing season.
