Expired Links

Keep track of when every dice link was posted. Attempt to redeem only fresh links as the majority go stale in a short span. Refresh your preferred link source every few days to obtain new, working links. If you find a dead link, inform other people by posting in a reliable user forum or group. App Not Opening
